In case of three way tie, the second tiebreaker shall be goal difference among the three tied teams in the games played between the three teams, with the three teams ranked by their goal difference; if one team is above or below the other two teams who remain tied on goal difference, then head to head shall be used to break the tie between the two remaining tied teams.
